Any exhibitor entering a walk/jog or walk/trot class, regardless of horse, MAY NOT enter a lope/canter class. EXCEPTION is if exhibiting a 2 year old horse then that same competitor CAN enter that horse in walk/jog/trot classes and a different horse in lope/canter classes. A horse can be shown twice in each trail or speed event class but by two different exhibitors.

Cloud 9 Ranch July 20th 2024, Horse Show Rules and Regulations

1. Entries will be accepted by email to Tara Reimer tara@cloud9ranch.ca , by dropping off at Cloud 9 Ranch in locked cash box in barn classroom or on show day. Payment by e transfer to above email, automatic deposit, leave a cheque/cash clearly marked on envelope in classroom lock box or bring on day of show.
2. There will be a show secretary able to accept entries at the show. We are using a ticket system so you will be given tickets which you will need to write your exhibitor number onto and then hand one in at the gate before entering the class. NO CLASS ENTRY without your ticket so have a safe place or person to hold them. You can sell your tickets to others or buy more during the day but you may NOT get a refund if not used.
3. Exhibitor numbers were assigned and handed out at first CWHA sanctioned show. If this is your first show of CWHA season, the office will have a number for you on show morning.
4. Show is NAERIC approved so please use correct spelling of horse's registered name on entry form.
5. Refunds will only be given if illness/lameness of horse for which a vet certificate is required, or if exhibitor ill/injured.
6. Prize money will be issued by e transfer or cheque within 2 weeks of the show. Please give proper details on entry form.
7. This show follows AQHA rules and regulations. Junior horses 5 years and under may be ridden 1 handed on shank or 2 handed on snaffle. Senior horses are 6 years and older and must be ridden 1 handed on a shank. Exception is speed events and English classes. Walk/Jog exhibitors, regardless of horse's age, may ride 2 handed on snaffle or 1 handed on shank. Any adults staying with a child in the arena, other than lead line, will place that child last in the class. No riding doubles.
8. Lead line is intended for those unable to yet control their own horse in a horse show group setting.
9. Unprofessional behavior including foul language, bullying, cruel or inhumane treatment of animals WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. Said person will be asked to leave the grounds immediately and no refunds of entry fees given.
10. Dogs brought on grounds must be on a leash. If there is barking or disturbance to horses, dogs will need to be removed from grounds immediately.
11. Please do not use the automatic waterers. Bring your own pails for water.
12. DO NOT use spray paint or hoof black on our concrete anywhere on the yard or in the barn.
13. No smoking near barns, equipment, buildings, or hay. Throw cigarette butts in garbage!
14. Clean up manure behind your horse on our yard and indoor arena. Please and thank you!
15. Stallions may only be shown by a senior competitor.
16. No run-ins for speed events. The gate must be closed before run can start.
17. Proper attire/footwear required. Half chaps and paddock boots accepted in English. All exhibitors under 18 years old must wear an ASTM approved riding helmet for all riding classes.
18. Stakes classes have added money plus 90% of entry fees paid out 40-30-20-10.
19. The judge's decision is final. To be considered, protests regarding the show shall be made in writing within 7 days of cause of protest to Tara Reimer and shall be accompanied by a \$50 cash deposit which will be forfeited if the protest is not sustained.
20. Cloud 9 Ranch is not responsible for accidents or loss or damage to property that may occur on the grounds. Our waiver must be signed in 2024. We recommend you obtain a Manitoba Horse Council for your own liability insurance, however it is not required.
21. Please bring your own food as a canteen will NOT be available.
22. Stalls will not be available for those wanting to stay overnight. A few corrals can be made available.
23. The grounds will open at 6:30 am and close one hour after the last class.
24. Spectators welcome and no charge! Bring your own chairs.
